Intro to Statistical Literacy:

is the ability to understand and critically evaluate statistical results that permeate our daily lives – coupled with the ability to appreciate the contributions that statistical thinking can make in public and private, professional and personal decisions

citizens without statistical literacy may not be able to discriminate between credible and incredible information and will have difficulty in interpreting, critically evaluating and communicating reactions to such messages

The Statistical literacy is so far important that many of statistical community put it is university curriculum and developing material for a new course which is aimed at encouraging students to learn statistics based on our findings

Labour force statistic is one of the debating statistics that needs the specific literacy. 






Misclassification and wrong definition

Employment: work performed for others in exchange for pay or profit

Own-use production work: production of goods and services for own final use

Unpaid trainee work: work performed for others without pay to acquire workplace experience and skills

Volunteer work: noncompulsory work performed for others without pay

Other work activities (not defined in this resolution)















Time-related underemployment

Many of employed (time-related) or Unemployed (Potential labour force) do not working as the fulltime standard employees (e.g. 44 hours a week).



Unemployment Concept

Labour underutilization diagram for better understanding



Unemployment reflects the active search for existing employment opportunities by jobless persons who are available for work

- all those above a specified age, who were not in employment
- 2) carried out activities to seek employment during a specified recent period
- 3) were currently available to take up employment given a job opportunity














Definition by Income and wage

- consideration unit in the LFS survey is an individual persons and LFS is a household based survey
- different employees have different incomes, various living costs patterns, incomparable working time and it would be implausible to use the income as criteria for employment statues, thought it will be need to simultaneous analysis the relation between employees' wage and living costs, and it is highly complicated to put a standard for welfare and comprehensive acceptable pattern
- for measuring the employment status is a reference week while the reference suitable period for measuring the income is a year
- Complexity of calculation of income is related to whole family rather than the breadwinner



those who do not afford their living costs should not be counted as employees

Definition by Working Hours

1 Usually work less than the hour's threshold, and who wanted and were available to

work additional hours

Time-related employee 1-8 hours ~ 1 day overtime ····· 1-16 hours ~ 2 days employee 1-24 hours ~ 3 days

Workplace and ownership

Usually work more than the hour's threshold but who were "not at work" or had reduced working time during the short reference period, due to specific reasons (such as reduction in economic activity including temporary lay-off and slack work, and the low or off-season







Formality and informality

- Own-account workers, employers members of producers' cooperatives of informal sector units
- All contributing family workers

It also should not subject to national labour legislation, income taxation, social protection or entitlement to certain employment benefits (advance notice of dismissal, severance pay, paid annual or sick leave).

According to the all of reflections, the unemployment rate is the first and most relevant index that respondents motioned immediately, but they didn't care about the detailed indices.






















Sample population flow for tow considered quarters
